


# ALBERTO LAGO

The possibility of creating common activities that gather people together, to share the same experiences, to break down physical limits in urban contexts.


Communities taking back these in-between spaces, allowing for the sharing of experience, beliefs and permanent initiatives to recover unused areas in cities.
